

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

Hiawassee water may be temporary  
muddy or rusty on Tuesday, September 30  
through Thursday, October 2, 2014

As a requirement of the City of Hiawassee's Corrosion Control Program and as mandated by the State E.P.D., the City of Hiawassee will be flushing its Fire Hydrants on **Tuesday, September 30 through Thursday, October 2, 2014**. Some residents may experience muddy, rusty or cloudy water on these days. This is normal when Hydrants are flushed.

Care should be taken to abstain from washing clothes or the like on these days. Please check your water before doing laundry or bathing. If you experience muddy or rusty water, please open the cold water tap in your bathtub and let the water run until it clears.

This flushing clears deposits and sedimentation from water pipes and is intended to improve taste and odor. It is the policy of Hiawassee to flush water lines twice per year. The next flushing will be in April 2015.
